As a functionalist / SME, you will be responsible for:

- Providing domain expertise and insights to inform data collection, processing, modeling, and analysis.
- Reviewing and validating data sources, data quality, data transformations, and data outputs
- Developing and presenting reports, dashboards, and recommendations based on data analysis and findings.
- Communicating complex data concepts and results in a clear and concise manner to various audiences.
- Identifying opportunities and challenges for data analytics in the domain area and proposing solutions and best practices.

- Strong analytical and critical thinking skills
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a fast-paced environment.
